

## Bris Honors

_____	<b>קוּוּטְרִין , קוּוּטְרִין / Kwater , Kvaterin</b>	The couple or individuals, honored with bringing the baby into the room where the Bris ceremony is to take place.
_____	<b>כְּסָא שֶׁל אֵלִיָּהוּ / Kisay Shel Eliyahu</b>	The one honored to take the baby from the Kwater and place him on the Chair of Eliyahu Hanavi.
_____	<b>מִן הַכְּסָא / Min Hakisay</b>	The one honored to take the baby from the chair and hand the baby to his father, who then places him on the lap of the honored Sandek.
_____	<b>סַנְדֵּק / Sandek</b>	The one honored with holding the baby during the Bris Milah.
<u>Rabbi Rubin</u>	<b>מֹוֹהֵל / Mohel</b>	The one honored with performing the circumcision.
_____	<b>בְּרָכוֹת / Brochos Blessings</b>	The one honored with reciting the Bris blessings on a cup of wine.
_____	<b>עֲמִידָה לְבְּרָכוֹת / Amidah Lebrochos</b>	The one honored with holding the now circumcised baby during the Bris blessings.
_____	<b>קְרִיאַת שֵׁם / Krias Shem</b>	The one honored with naming the baby.
_____	<b>עֲמִידָה לְקְרִיאַת שֵׁם / Amidah Lkrias Shem</b>	The one honored with holding the baby during his naming.
